*Exemption Option: Praxis Core is waived for the licensure-only program for a person who graduated with a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university with a 2.70 cumulative grade point average.

Licensure-only students with less than a 2.70 grade point average will be admitted to the Teacher Education Program with a passing score on the Praxis Core Exams (reading, writing, and mathematics) and one of the following conditions: 1) a grade point average of 3.00 in the major field of study, 2) a grade point average of 3.00 on all work completed in the senior year; or 3) a grade point average of 3.00 on a minimum of 15 semester hours of coursework related to licensure and completed during the preceding five years.

*Additional Exemption Options for the Praxis Core Tests:

Before 3/2016: Total of 1100 for Praxis Core or SAT Math 550 for Math or SAT Verbal 550 for Reading/Writing After 3/2016: Total of 1170 for Praxis Core or SAT Math 570 for Praxis Math or SAT evidence-based reading/writing 600 for Praxis Reading/Writing

OR ACT 24 Composite Score for all or ACT Math 24 for Math or ACT English 24 for Reading/Writing
